AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-621, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PUBLIC OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 38-621, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 38-621. Persons eligible to receive travel expenses

5 A. The provisions of this article ~~shall~~ apply to every public officer,
6 deputy or employee of ~~the~~ THIS state, or of any department, institution or
7 agency ~~thereof~~ OF THIS STATE, and to a member of any board, commission or
8 other agency of ~~the~~ THIS state when traveling on necessary public business
9 away from ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S designated post of duty and when issued a proper
10 travel order.

11 B. The designated post of duty of members of boards, commissions,
12 authorities, councils and committees who are not ~~fulltime~~ FULL-TIME employees
13 of the agency served by the board, commission, authority, council or
14 committee shall be deemed to be their place of residence.
