AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR CANCER RESEARCH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: health care institutions: cancer
3 research and treatment: matching monies: exemption

4 A. The sum of \$2,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
5 in fiscal year 2010-2011 to the department of health services for
6 distribution to health care institutions in Maricopa and Pima counties that
7 are designated by the National Cancer Institute, or by an organization that
8 is currently participating in women's cancer research grants, to perform
9 research, treatment, education and preventive research into cancers that are
10 unique to women. Institutions shall use the monies received pursuant to this
11 section for in-state programs. The department shall distribute these monies
12 as follows:

13 1. The sum of \$10,000,000 for institutions in Maricopa county.

14 2. The sum of \$5,000,000 for institutions in Pima county.

15 B. The amount distributed to each institution by the department shall
16 equal one-third of the monies raised by the institution from private sources
17 within an eighteen month period ending June 30, 2010. If in either county a
18 full state match would exceed the amount appropriated pursuant to subsection
19 A of this section, the department shall reduce proportionately the
20 distribution to each qualifying institution.

21 C. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
22 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
23 lapsing of appropriations until January 1, 2012.
