AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 35, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 35-144.01; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Title 35, chapter 1, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding section 35-144.01, to read:

35-144.01. Debt reduction fund

THE DEBT REDUCTION FUND IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE BUDGET STABILIZATION FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 35-144. THE LEGISLATURE SHALL APPROPRIATE MONIES IN THE DEBT REDUCTION FUND TO REDUCE AND ELIMINATE OUTSTANDING LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENTS AND REVENUE BOND ISSUANCES. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND, AND MONIES EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190 RELATING TO LAPSING OF APPROPRIATIONS.

Sec. 2. Appropriations; school facilities board lease-purchase payments; exemption

- A. The sum of \$200,000,000 is appropriated from the budget stabilization fund established by section 35-144, Arizona Revised Statutes, in fiscal year 2006-2007, to the debt reduction fund established by section 35-144.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act.
- B. The sum of \$200,000,000 is appropriated from the debt reduction fund established by section 35-144.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act in fiscal year 2006-2007 to the school facilities board for retirement of lease-purchase agreements.
- C. Prior to expenditure of any monies pursuant to subsection B of this section and on or before August 1, 2007, the school facilities board shall submit a lease-purchase agreement retirement plan, including savings in the debt service payments, to the joint legislative budget committee for its review.
- D. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations until June 30, 2008.

Sec. 3. School facilities board: transfer: appropriation

- A. Any debt service payment savings determined by the joint legislative budget committee pursuant to section 2 of this act shall be transferred from the state general fund amount appropriated to the school facilities board in the general appropriations act to the debt reduction fund established by section 35-144.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act.
- B. The amount transferred to the debt reduction fund pursuant to subsection A of this section is appropriated to the school facilities board from the debt reduction fund for additional retirement of lease-purchase agreements.
- C. Prior to expenditure of any monies pursuant to subsection B of this section and on or before December 1, 2007, the school facilities board shall submit a lease-purchase agreement retirement plan, including savings in the

debt service payments, to the joint legislative budget committee for its review.

D. The appropriation made in subsection B of this section is exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations until June 30, 2008.

Sec. 4. <u>Emergency</u>

This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by law.
