By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

- 1. This Order dismisses the Request for Review filed by Bullitt County School District (Bullitt County), Shepherdsville, Kentucky. Bullitt County seeks review of a decision issued by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator) on March 29, 2002. The Commission received Bullitt County's Request for Review on May 31, 2002.
