## H.R. 2464

An act to amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to exempt internationally adopted children under age 10 from the immunization requirement

As cleared by the Congress on November 4, 1997

H.R. 2464 would make it easier for a small number of adopted children under age 10 to obtain immigrant visas. Enacting H.R. 2464 could affect the amount of fees collected by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, but because the number of children affected would be very small, the estimated impact of H.R. 2464 on direct spending would be significantly less than \$500,000 annually. (The legislation would not affect governmental receipts.)
