Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: Section 1. <u>State archives and history building: purchase of</u> <u>property</u>

Pursuant to section 41-791.02, Arizona Revised Statutes, the director of the department of administration is authorized to purchase property adjacent to the site of the state archives and history building and located west of nineteenth avenue, south of Madison street, east of twentieth avenue and north of Jackson street. Monies appropriated by Laws 2004, chapter 194, section 1 shall be used to acquire any property purchased pursuant to this act.

Sec. 2. <u>Emergency</u>
