## AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2006, CHAPTER 381, SECTION 7; RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 3 Section 1. Laws 2006, chapter 381, section 7, is amended to read: Sec. 7. <u>Existing flags: display requirements</u>

A. A United States flag that is at least two feet by three feet OF 4 5 SUFFICIENT SIZE TO BE VISIBLE AND EASILY RECOGNIZABLE AS A UNITED STATES FLAG, THAT IS NOT MADE OF PAPER and THAT is present in a classroom at a 6 7 school district, charter school, community college or public university AND 8 displayed in accordance with title 4 of the United States Code as of June 30, 9 2006, may be used to meet the requirements of this act SECTION 15-506, 15-1445 OR 15-1626, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, UNTIL THAT FLAG NEEDS TO BE 10 11 REPLACED.

B. WHEN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHARTER SCHOOL, COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR PUBLIC
UNIVERSITY REPLACES AN EXISTING UNITED STATES FLAG THAT WAS LESS THAN TWO
FEET BY THREE FEET IN A CLASSROOM, THE REPLACEMENT FLAG SHALL BE AT LEAST TWO
FEET BY THREE FEET.
