# **HOUSE BILL 2487**

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY SCHOOL CAPACITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2       Section 1. Joint legislative study committee on private  
3                   postsecondary school capacity: membership: duties

4       A. The joint legislative study committee on private postsecondary  
5 school capacity is established consisting of the following members:

6       1. Three members of the senate who are appointed by the president of  
7 the senate, not more than two of whom are members of the same political  
8 party.

9       2. Three members of the house of representatives who are appointed by  
10 the speaker of the house of representatives, not more than two of whom are  
11 members of the same political party.

12       3. The president of a university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona  
13 board of regents who is appointed by the president of the senate.

14       4. The president of a nationally accredited private school who is  
15 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

16       5. The president of a regionally accredited private school who is  
17 appointed by the president of the senate.

18       6. The executive director of the state board for private postsecondary  
19 education or the executive director's designee.

20       7. The executive director of the commission for postsecondary  
21 education or the executive director's designee.

22       B. Appointed members serve at the pleasure of the appointing officer.  
23 The members shall elect a chairperson and vice-chairperson from among its  
24 members. The legislature shall provide staff support and meeting  
25 accommodations.

26       C. The committee shall:

27       1. Review the capacity and current market share of private  
28 postsecondary schools in this state and compare this data to data from other  
29 states.

30       2. Identify policies that hinder or promote the expansion of private  
31 sector postsecondary education.

32       3. Submit a written report of findings and recommendations on or  
33 before December 15, 2006 to the governor, the secretary of state, the  
34 director of the Arizona state library, archives and public records and any  
35 other person who requests a copy. The committee shall make the report  
36 available on the legislature's web site.

37       Sec. 2. Delayed repeal

38       This act is repealed from and after December 31, 2006.
