6 by striking "12/31/2006" and inserting "12/31/2008".

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by8 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
