This example shows sample label 1 modified to be consistent with the standardized GHS elements, which are highlighted in yellow. Note: Some GHS hazard communication elements are either identical or very similar to current requirements, including signal words and some hazard statements. For example, the hazard statement "Harmful if inhaled", which is currently used on many pesticide products, is highlighted because it is also an element of GHS. You may also notice that the signal word has changed from "Caution" to "Warning," as "Caution" is not used under GHS.

Precautionary statements are not standardized under GHS, but the GHS official text does recommend a selection of statements to increase the degree of harmonization achieved throughout international and domestic hazard communication.

In this example, the sample label is modified to reflect the standardized GHS label elements shown above, plus GHS precautionary statements, which are highlighted in green. *Note: Many of the GHS precautionary statements are identical or very similar to statements that are currently seen on pesticide products. For example, the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement which is currently required on most pesticide products is highlighted in green, as its use is also recommended by GHS. Some of the other statements may look familiar as well.*
