## S. 2504

## A bill to amend title 36, United States Code, to grant a federal charter to the Military Officers Association of America, and for other purposes

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary on May 8, 2008

S. 2504 would amend title 36 of the U.S. Code to grant a federal charter to the Military Officers Association of America, a nonprofit, tax-exempt, veterans organization. Because chartered organizations listed in title 36 are not agencies of the U.S. government and are conferred no federal benefits, CBO estimates that enacting this bill would have no impact on the federal budget.

S. 2504 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
