

CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE COST ESTIMATE

S. 2512 Mississippi Delta National Heritage Area Act of 2008

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources on May 7, 2008

S. 2512 would establish the Mississippi Delta National Heritage Area (NHA) in Mississippi and designate the Mississippi Delta National Heritage Area Partnership, a local nonprofit organization, as the management entity for the NHA. The bill would authorize the appropriation of \$10 million, not to exceed \$1 million annually, for financial assistance to the Partnership and other eligible entities over the next 15 years.

Assuming appropriation of the authorized amounts, CBO estimates that implementing S. 2512 would cost \$5 million over the 2009-2013 period and an additional \$5 million after 2013. Enacting the legislation would have no effect on direct spending or revenues.

S. 2512 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
