### Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Aqueous polyure thane dispersions containing 29% to 31% solids content of hexanedioic acid, polymer with N-(2-aminoethyl)-1,2-ethanediamine, 2-butene-1,4-diol, 1,6-diisocyanatohexane, 1,2-ethanediol, 1,3-isobenzofurandione, methyloxirane, oxirane and sodium hydrogen sulfite, 2-(2butoxyethoxy)ethanol-blocked (CAS No. 100486-94-0) (provided for in subheading 3909.50.50).

#### **Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

The product is sold under the trade name BAYDERM® BOTTOM 10 UD to the leather industry. It is an aqueous fine-particle size polyurethane dispersion containing between 29 percent to 31 percent solids used as a surface coating for automotive seating leather. BAYDERM® produces a very soft film providing excellent flexibility; excellent wet and dry adhesion; and very good embossing properties. The product does not harden even very soft leathers. It is primarily used in basecoats and exhibits no appreciable loading effect on the leather grain. This material is compounded with other materials to create a surface coating paint for automotive leather. BAYDERM® BOTTOM 10 UD is imported from Germany.
