AN ACT

CHANGING THE TERM OF A PUBLIC MEMBER OF THE STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section. 1. State board of accountancy: public member term

3 A. Notwithstanding section 32-702, subsection C, Arizona Revised
4 Statutes, one public member of the state board of accountancy who is
5 appointed pursuant to section 32-702, subsection B, paragraph 2, Arizona
6 Revised Statutes, and whose term ends on July 3, 2009 shall be replaced by a
7 public member serving a three year term. The governor may remove the member
8 for neglect of duty or other just cause. The governor shall fill vacancies
9 by appointment for the unexpired term. The appointee to the three year term
10 pursuant to this subsection is eligible for reappointment for a full term by
11 the governor.

12 B. The governor shall make all subsequent appointments as prescribed
13 by statute.
