AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 22-244, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO CIVIL PROCEEDINGS IN JUSTICE COURT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 22-244, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 22-244. Writ of execution; notice of judgment

5 A. The judgment of a justice of the peace shall be enforced by
6 execution or other appropriate process.

7 B. The execution or process shall describe the judgment and command
8 the sheriff or A constable to execute it according to its terms, whether the
9 judgment is to make a sum of money, ~~or~~ to deliver personal property or
10 possession of real property, ~~or~~ to do some other thing.

11 C. The execution or process shall be returnable in sixty days.

12 D. AT ANY TIME AFTER AN ENTRY OF JUDGMENT, THE PARTY IN WHOSE FAVOR A
13 JUDGMENT IS GIVEN MAY REQUEST THAT THE COURT ISSUE A NOTICE OF WRIT OF
14 EXECUTION.

15 E. A NOTICE OF A WRIT OF EXECUTION SHALL DESCRIBE THE JUDGMENT AND MAY
16 BE SERVED BY THE SHERIFF, A CONSTABLE OR A PERSON DULY AUTHORIZED TO SERVE
17 PROCESS.
