AMENDING SECTION 12-1509, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ARBITRATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 12-1509, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 12-1509. Change of award by arbitrators

5 On application of a party or, if an application to the court is pending
6 under ~~sections~~ SECTION 12-1511, 12-1512 or 12-1513, on submission to the
7 arbitrators by the court under such conditions as the court may order, the
8 arbitrators may modify or correct the award ~~upon~~ ON the grounds stated in
9 ~~paragraphs 1 and 3 of subsection A of~~ section 12-1513, SUBSECTION A,
10 PARAGRAPHS 1 AND 3, or for the purpose of clarifying the award. The
11 application shall be made within twenty days after delivery of the award to
12 the applicant. Written notice ~~thereof~~ OF THE AWARD shall be given forthwith
13 to the opposing party, stating he must serve his objections thereto, if any,
14 within ~~ten~~ FOURTEEN days from the notice. The award so modified or corrected
15 is subject to ~~the provisions of~~ sections 12-1511, 12-1512 and 12-1513.
