AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 1.2; RELATING TO ELECTION DAY VOTER REGISTRATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 by adding article 1.2, to read:

4 ARTICLE 1.2. ELECTION DAY VOTER REGISTRATION

5 16-115. Registration on election day; exception; definition

6 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION B  
7 OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED TO REGISTER TO VOTE MAY  
8 REGISTER ON ELECTION DAY BY APPEARING AT THE POLLING PLACE FOR THE PRECINCT  
9 IN WHICH THAT PERSON MAINTAINS THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE, COMPLETING A  
10 REGISTRATION FORM AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 16-152 AND PROVIDING PROOF OF  
11 RESIDENCE.

12 B. REGISTRATION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION QUALIFIES THE PERSON TO VOTE  
13 ONLY FOR CANDIDATES FOR FEDERAL OFFICES, INCLUDING PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS,  
14 STATEWIDE AND COUNTYWIDE OFFICES AND THE LEGISLATURE, BUT DOES NOT QUALIFY A  
15 PERSON TO VOTE IN A PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION.

16 C. THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND COUNTY OFFICERS IN CHARGE OF ELECTIONS  
17 SHALL PROMPTLY IMPLEMENT THIS ARTICLE.
