The above-captioned case, petitioning for an investigation and determination of representative under Section 9 (c) of the National Labor Relations Act, as amended, has been carefully investigated and considered.

The Employer has entered into a settlement agreement in Case 13-CA-43862, wherein it acknowledges that it engaged in conduct which caused employee dissatisfaction with the Automobile Mechanics Local 701, Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, IAM as their bargaining representative. Inasmuch as this employee dissatisfaction led to the filing of the decertification petition, it will not be processed and is dismissed.

Accordingly, the petition is hereby dismissed.

Pursuant to the National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations, Series 8, as amended, you may obtain a review of this action by filing a request thereof with the National Labor Relations Board, addressed to the Executive Secretary, National Labor Relations Board, Washington, D.C. 20570. A copy of such review must be served on me and each of the other parties to the proceeding. This request for review must contain a complete statement setting forth the facts and reasons upon which it is based. The request for review (eight copies) must be received by the Executive Secretary of the Board in Washington, D.C., by the close of business on April 20, 2007. Upon good cause shown, however, the Board may grant special permission for a longer period within which to file. The request for extension of time should be submitted to the Executive Secretary of the Board in Washington, D.C., and a copy of any such request for extension of time should be submitted to me, and to each of the other parties to this proceeding.

The request for review and any request for extension of time for filing must include a statement that a copy has been served on me and on each of the other parties to this proceeding, and the copy must be served in the same or faster manner as that utilized in filing the request with the Board. When filing with the Board is accomplished by personal service, however, the other parties shall be promptly notified of such action by telephone, followed by service of a copy by mail or telegraph.

In the Regional Office's initial correspondence, the parties were advised that the National Labor Relations Board has expanded the list of permissible documents that may be electronically filed with its offices. If a party wishes to file one of the documents which may now be filed electronically, please refer to the Attachment supplied with the Regional Office's initial correspondence for guidance in doing so.
