# Beans and Pulses Monthly Trade Report - October 2003

#### **Report Highlights:**

Exports of beans and pulses remained steady, with 99,008 metric tons exported, down only two percent from September's level but up by 21 percent over the previous year's level. India remained the primary buyer, taking 88 percent of the exports.

#### **TRADE**

During the month of October, Burma exported 99,008 metric tons (mt) of beans and pulses. Black Matpe comprised 46 percent, Toor Whole (Pigeon pea) 34 percent and Chickpeas 9 percent of the total beans and pulses export. The major destination was India who took 88 percent of the total exports. There was an increase of 21 percent in October exports compared to the same month of the previous year.

#### **Domestic Market Situation**

Prices for export ready cargoes strengthened due to the demand from India, whereas domestic prices remained slightly depressed. Even though prices for export ready Matpe strengthened, the market was not very active. There was a decrease of 2 percent in exports compared to the previous month when exports reached 100,575 mt of beans and pulses.
