- 3 SECTION 1. STUDY AND REPORT ON FOREIGN PRICE CON-
- 4 TROLS ON PHARMACEUTICALS.
- 5 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General shall conduct
- 6 a study on—
- 7 (1) the impact of price controls of foreign gov-
- 8 ernments on pharmaceuticals, including the impact

- 1 of such price controls on full market access for
- 2 United States pharmaceuticals and on increased
- 3 prices for pharmaceuticals generally for United
- 4 States consumers; and
- 5 (2) the extent to which negotiations conducted
- 6 by the United States Trade Representative under
- 7 the Bipartisan Trade Promotion Authority Act of
- 8 2002 (title XXI of division B of the Trade Act of
- 9 2002) facilitate the elimination of such price con-
- trols of foreign governments on pharmaceuticals.
- 11 (b) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date
- 12 of the enactment of this Act, and every 5 years thereafter,
- 13 the Comptroller General shall prepare and submit to Con-
- 14 gress a report that contains the results of the study con-
- 15 ducted under subsection (a) for the preceding 1- or 5-year
- 16 period (as the case may be).
