## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on 5-Chloro-1-indanone  
(EK179).

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. 5-CHLORO-1-INDANONE (EK179).**

4        (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5        the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6        amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7        new heading:

“	9902.07.47	5-Chloro-1-indanone (CAS No. 42348–86–7) (provided for in subheading 2914.39.90) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
