3 **SECTION 1. METHYL-4-TRIFLUOROMETHOXYPHENYL-*N*-**
4 **(CHLOROCARBONYL) CARBAMATE (DPX-**
5 **KL540).**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.91 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 Methyl-4-trifluoromethoxyphenyl-*N*-(chlorocarbonyl) car-
9 bamate) is amended by striking “12/31/2003” and insert-
10 ing “12/31/2009”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
