MARY TOBEY IS NAMED REGIONAL ATTORNEY IN NLRB'S ST. LOUIS REGIONAL OFFICE

Ronald Meisburg, General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board, today announced the appointment of Mary J. Tobey as Regional Attorney in the NLRB's St. Louis, MO Regional Office (Region 14).
