Ronald Meisburg, General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board, today announced the appointment of Kelly Selvidge as Assistant to the Regional Director in the NLRB's Denver, CO Regional Office (Region 27).

She joined the NLRB as a student assistant in the Los Angeles, CA Regional Office (Region 31) in 1984. After working as a Field Examiner in the NLRB's Brooklyn, NY Regional Office (Region 29) from 1985 until 1990, she returned to the Los Angeles area in 1991 to work in Region 21. She was promoted to Supervisory Field Examiner in that office in 1992.
