## **Grants Online (GOL):**

- Implemented in February of 2005 with automated interface to Grants.gov for grant application loading to GOL.
- Currently GOL is considered in Operations and Maintenance phase and remains a "project" until further system stabilization.
- New software releases delivered, tested, and implemented every 6-8 weeks to resolve system issues identified, and to implement critical system enhancements.
- GOL has been deployed to all NOAA Grantee organizations for award acceptance and input of financial status reports.
- GOL C&A package completed and awaiting final approval.
- Transition to new GOL Operations and Maintenance contract underway Requirements analysis of other DOC bureaus complete and awaiting DOC decision.
- Support structures in place for GOL and led by the ASD Project Manager staff include: active Change Control Board (CCB), User Group meetings, Grantee Conference Calls, formal Help Desk environment with configuration

- management and trouble ticket tracking and escalation, Internal Project Management office (PMO) meetings, and PMO-PMO (Gov to contractor) meetings.
- GOL staffing includes dedicated contractor staff from Bearing Point and RSIS, and Federal staff matrixed to GOL from ASD/SDB, ASD/SAB, and FACD.
- AGO/Grants Management Division (GMD) staff provides functional support to the project.
- GOL staff is located in Germantown, Landover, and Silver Spring NOAA sites.

## Executive Dashboard – Grants:

- Initial software version designed and developed for the NOAA Chief of Staff.
- Currently Executive Dashboard is under enhancement development to include additional functionality as requested by the Chief of Staff.
- Contractor support for Completion of enhancements and "adaptive maintenance".
