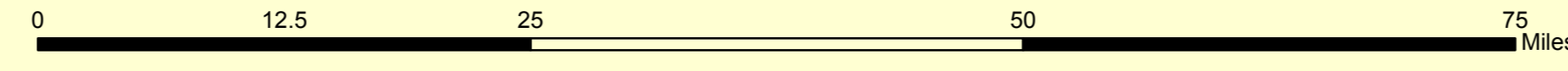
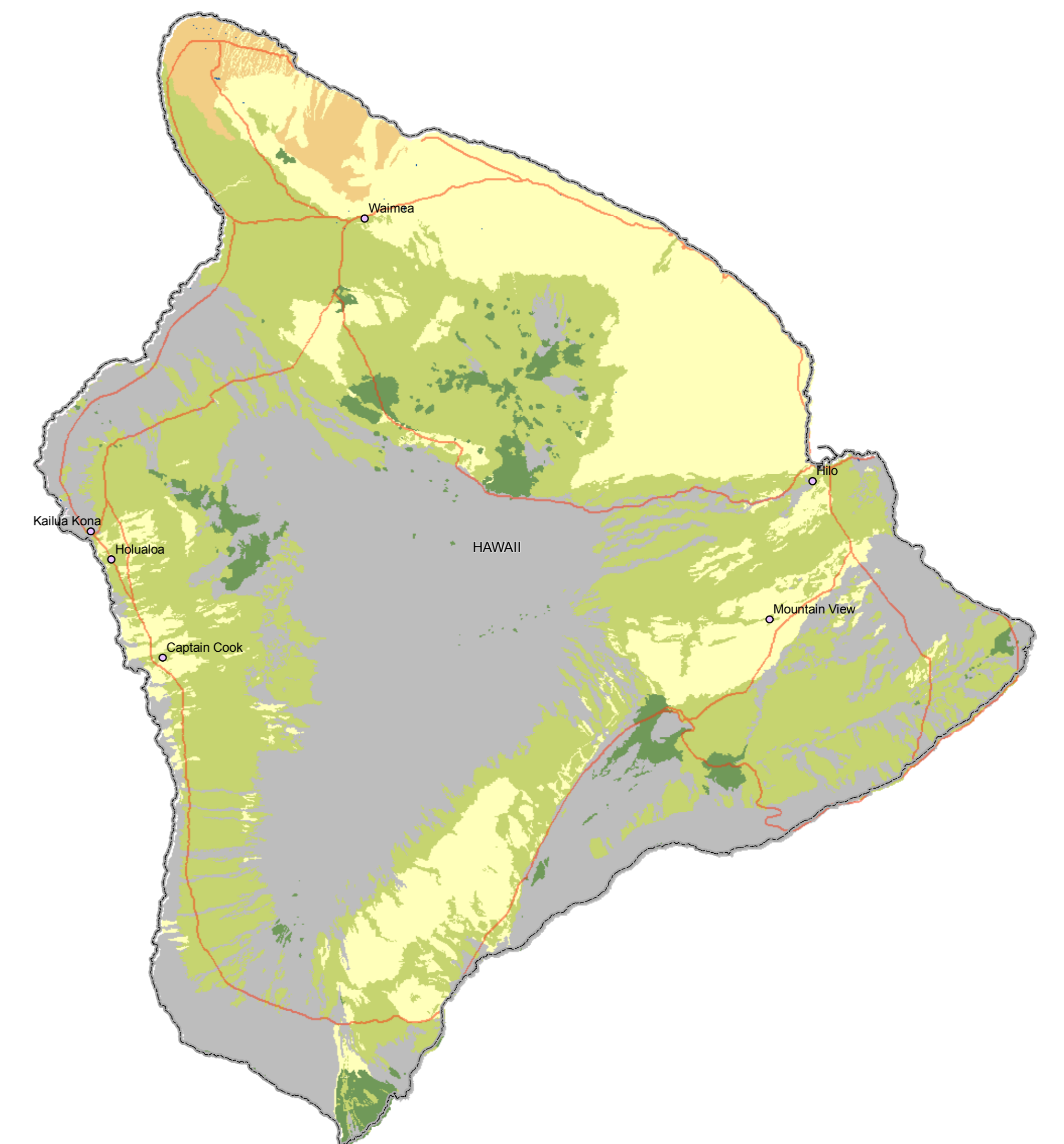
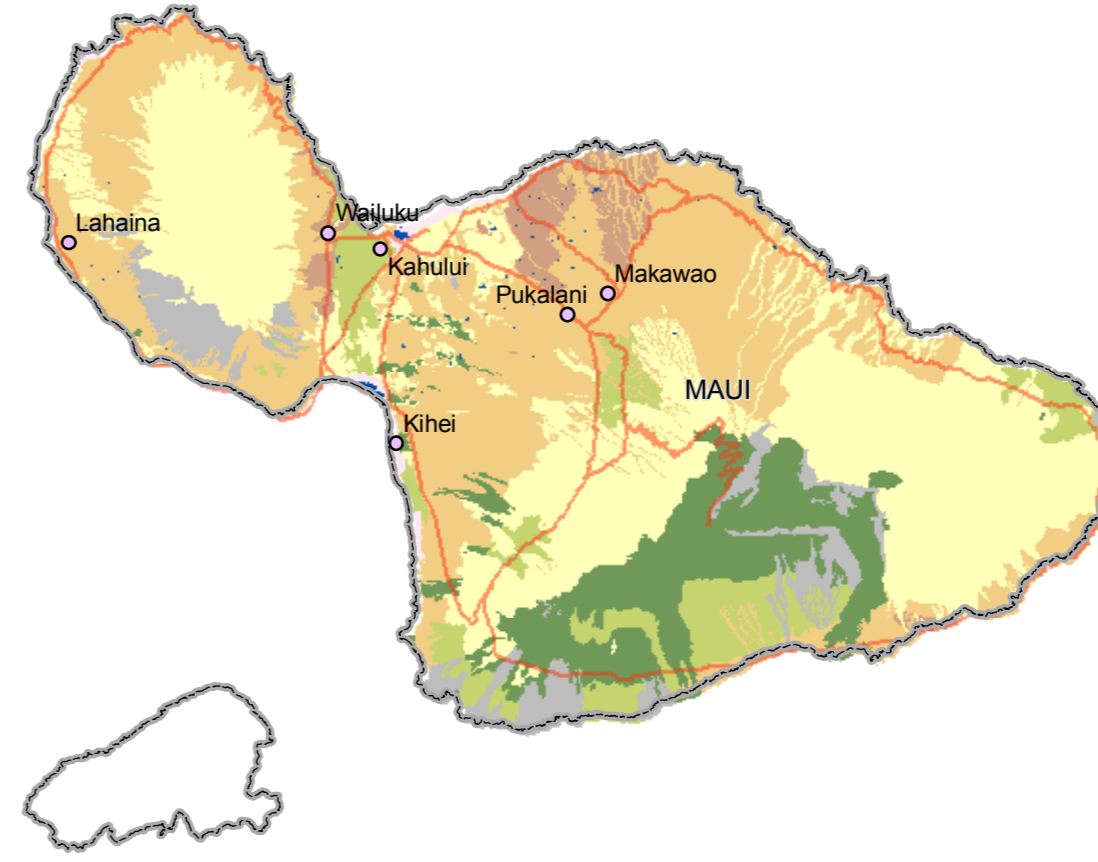
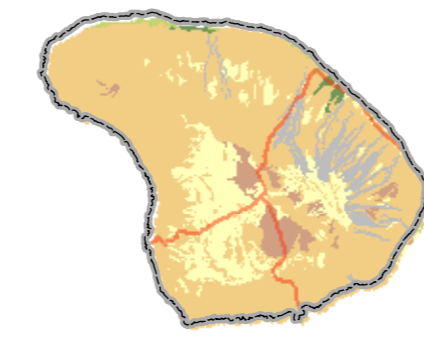
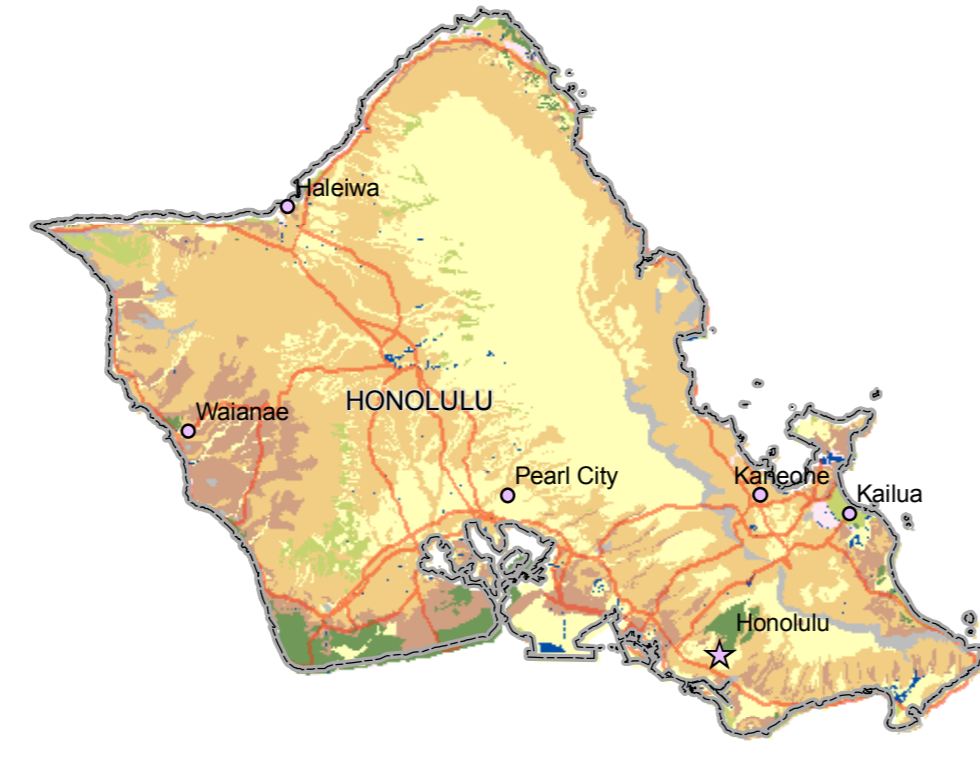
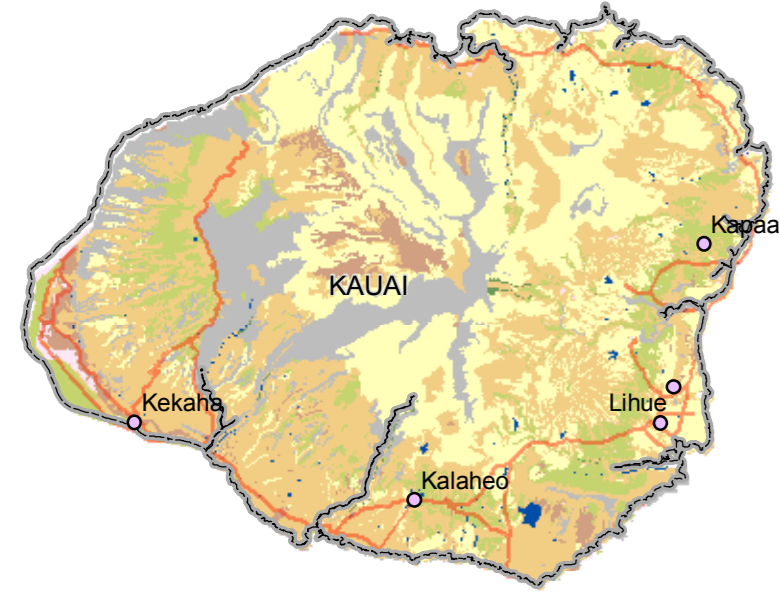



# Ground-Penetrating Radar Soil Suitability Map of Hawaii
