**AMENDING SECTION 28-301, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATE
TRANSPORTATION DISTRICTS.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-301, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-301. Transportation districts

5 A. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION B, the state is divided into six
6 transportation districts as follows:

7 1. First district, Maricopa county.

8 2. Second district, Pima county.

9 3. Third district, Cochise, Greenlee and Santa Cruz counties.

10 4. Fourth district, Gila, Graham and Pinal counties.

11 5. Fifth district, Apache, Coconino and Navajo counties.

12 6. Sixth district, La Paz, Mohave, Yavapai and Yuma counties.

13 B. IF, AFTER JANUARY 1, 2008, A COUNTY ATTAINS A POPULATION OF FIVE
14 HUNDRED THOUSAND OR MORE PERSONS, A NEW DISTRICT SHALL BE FORMED CONSISTING
15 OF ONLY THAT COUNTY. THE COUNTY SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE DISTRICT IT WAS IN
16 BEFORE THE NEW DISTRICT WAS FORMED.
