

Camden **LEAKE-INGHAM BUILDING**, 926 Washington St., NW, c. 1850. Frame, clapboarding; 1 story, gabled roof, rectangular, paneled center front entrance with dog-eared architrave molding and flanking large double-hung windows with similar moldings; full-width front balustraded porch with simple entablature and decorative pierced tympanum vent; building moved here to prevent demolition, 1954. Vernacular Greek Revival. Building has housed law, government, and business offices, a library, and most recently, a museum. *Private*.
