## **GRH FISCAL YEAR 2005 FUNDING STATUS**

AMPLE GRH Funds Available

Through September 30!!

75 percent of the national appropriation of over \$3.28

billion has been utilized during the first 10 months of this fiscal year.

Ample GRH funding should remain available throughout the balance of this fiscal year.

Approximately Year to date, Wisconsin has obligated 773 GRH loans for a total of \$81.3 million. Compared to a year ago, our GRH loan volume is down about 8 percent; however, Wisconsin ranks ninth nationally in terms of GRH funds utilized this fiscal year.

### UPDATES TO ORIGINATION AND SERVICING HANDBOOKS

### **UNDERWRITING ANS REISSUED**

On May 4, 2005, **RD AN 4081**, **Condominium Requirements**, was issued. This AN clarifies the Agency requirements and underwriting lender responsibilities for determining if a condominium is eligible for financing in the GRH loan program. The AN has three tables that describe the types of condominiums approved or accepted by HUD, Fannie Mae, and Freddie Mac. As in the past, the lender's underwriter will be required to provide a certification to the Agency that the condominium has been approved or accepted by HUD, VA, Fannie Mae, or Freddie Mac in order for the property to be eligible for GRH financing. On May 6, 2005, **RD AN 4080**, **Treatment of Applicant Collection Accounts**, was issued to replace RD AN 3970 with the same title. This AN explains the Agency requirements and underwriting lender responsibilities when determining what collection accounts, if any, should be paid by the borrower prior to or at loan closing.

### **RESERVATION OF FUNDS**



Please continue to fax your Requests for Reservation of Funds to Rural Development as part of your loan processing so that we can accurately monitor the volume of loans in your pipeline. You will notice that on "Confirmation of Funds" issued after August 1, the expiration date is the end of our fiscal year, September 30, 2005. If you have previously reserved funds on a loan that will not be closing as a GRH loan, please contact Rural Development to cancel the reservation amount so that the funds can be used by another home buyer.
