Report Highlights: Forecasts for 1998/99 citrus production, particularly for oranges and tangerines, have declined further than expected due to hail and colder than normal weather during the final phases of harvest. Total citrus production is estimated to be $2,595 \mathrm{mt}$, with orange and tangerine production down $25 \%$ and $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$ respectively from 1997. Italian imports remained high and exports lagged due to continued strong competition from Spain. However, fresh orange exports increased slightly and orange juice exports returned to previous levels following a drop in 1997.

## SECTION I: SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

The decline in 1998/99 Italian citrus production noted in the November 98 citrus report is now forecast to be even greater due to hail and lower than normal temperatures during the last part of the harvest season (February-March 1999). Prior to this damage, the citrus crops had already been heavily affected by extremely high temperatures in the summer of 1998.

Final trade data for the 1997/98 marketing year confirms an increasing trend of orange and citrus imports into Italy, mainly from Spain, due to that country's growing price competitiveness.

In MY 1997/98 Italian exports of tangerines, lemons and grapefruits also declined due to the growing strength of Spain in the European market. Only exports of Italian oranges increased from MY 1996/97 levels although the amount is marginal, representing only $6 \%$ of domestic output. Almost all exports of fresh fruit go to other European Union countries.

Italian grapefruit imports continue to stagnate due to declining domestic consumption. A small of amount of U.S. grapefruits are believed to have been transhipped into Italy from the Netherlands and France, but actual numbers are difficult to determine.

Final 1998 trade data for the Italian orange juice sector confirms a recovery of Italian exports to average levels after a drop in 1997 due to a strong price competition from Brazilian juice. Most exports are destined for other EU countries. The price of Brazilian concentrated orange juice remains the major factor affecting Italian exports.

The Italian Government recently announced that a program will soon be implemented in order to improve the Italian citrus industry. The plan, budgeted at 110 billion Lire, or about $\$ 60$ million and will support the citrus research, programs to improve the quality of citrus crops, restore and build processing plants, and to improve marketing organizations. According to some trade contacts, this plan is little more than a subsidy to Italian citrus sector, with 80 per cent of expenditures targeting Sicily, which suffers from high unemployment and infrastructural problems.
